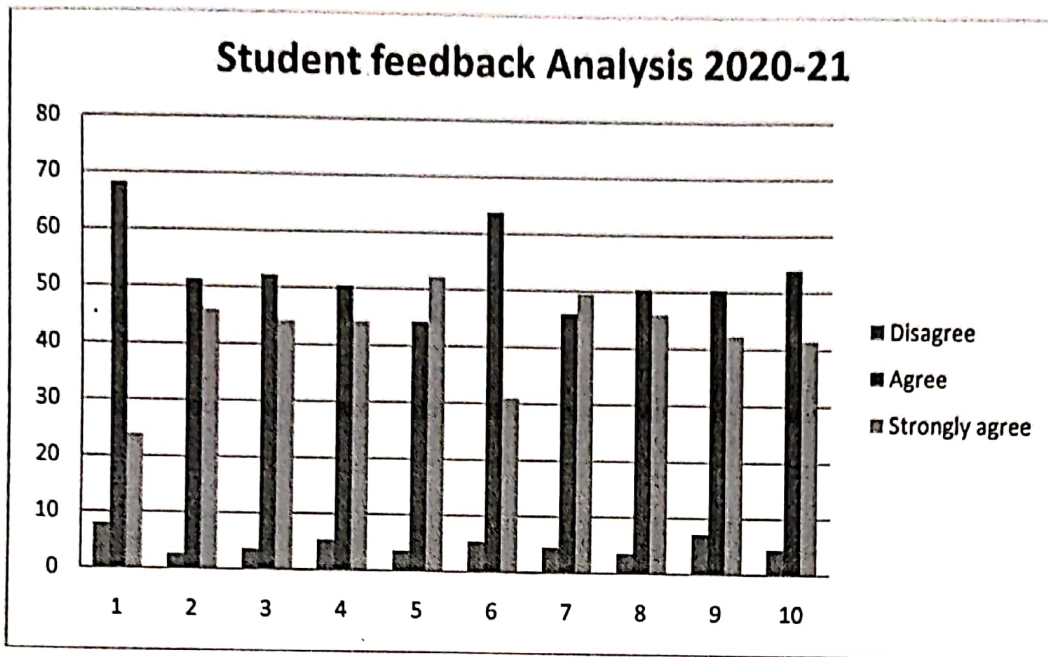

On an average 4.757% Disagree, 53.076% Agree, 42.105% strongly agree with the current syllabus of the various programmes.


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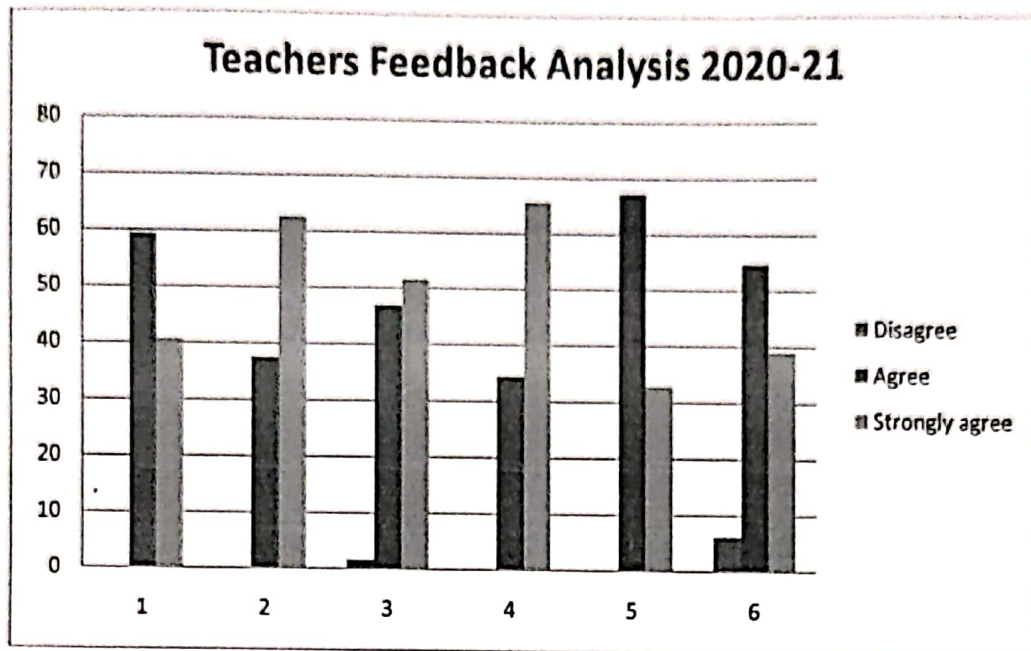
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Teachers Feedback:

On an average 1.3% Disagree, 49.99% Agree, 48.68% strongly agree with the current syllabus of the various programmes.


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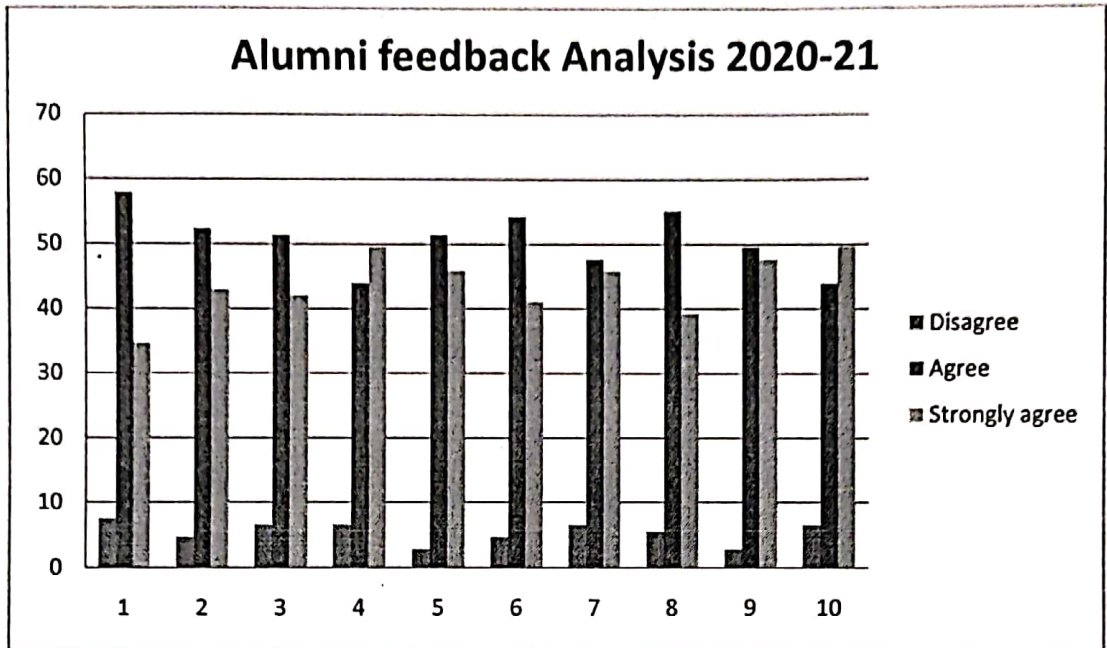
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Alumni feedback:

On an average 5.41% Disagree, 50.74% Agree, 43.83% strongly agree with the current syllabus of the various programmes.


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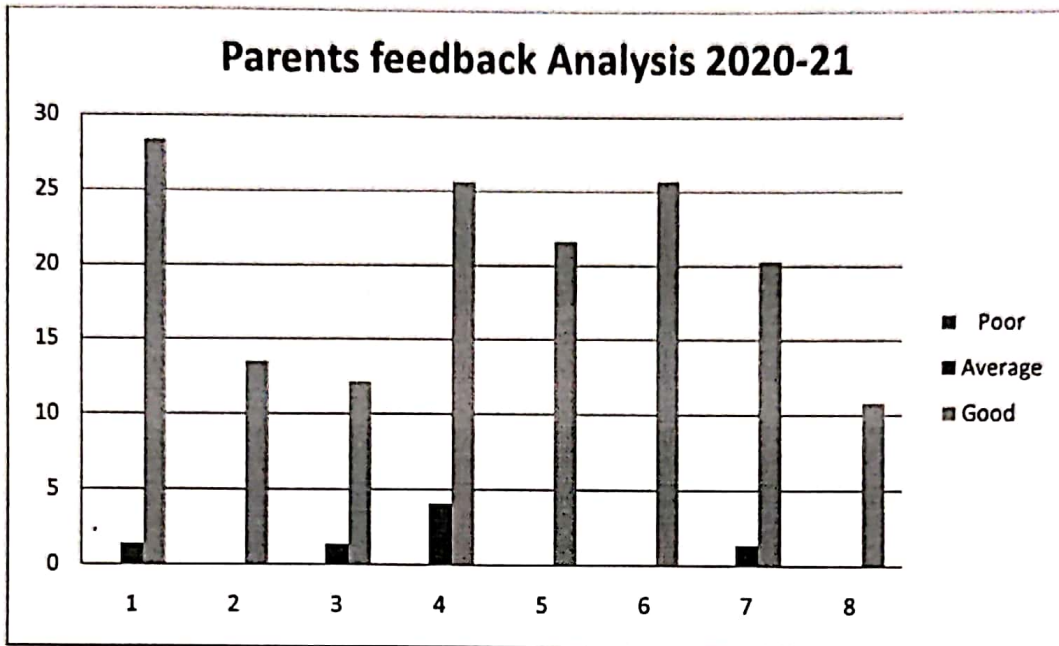
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Parents feedback:
